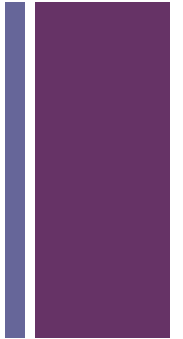

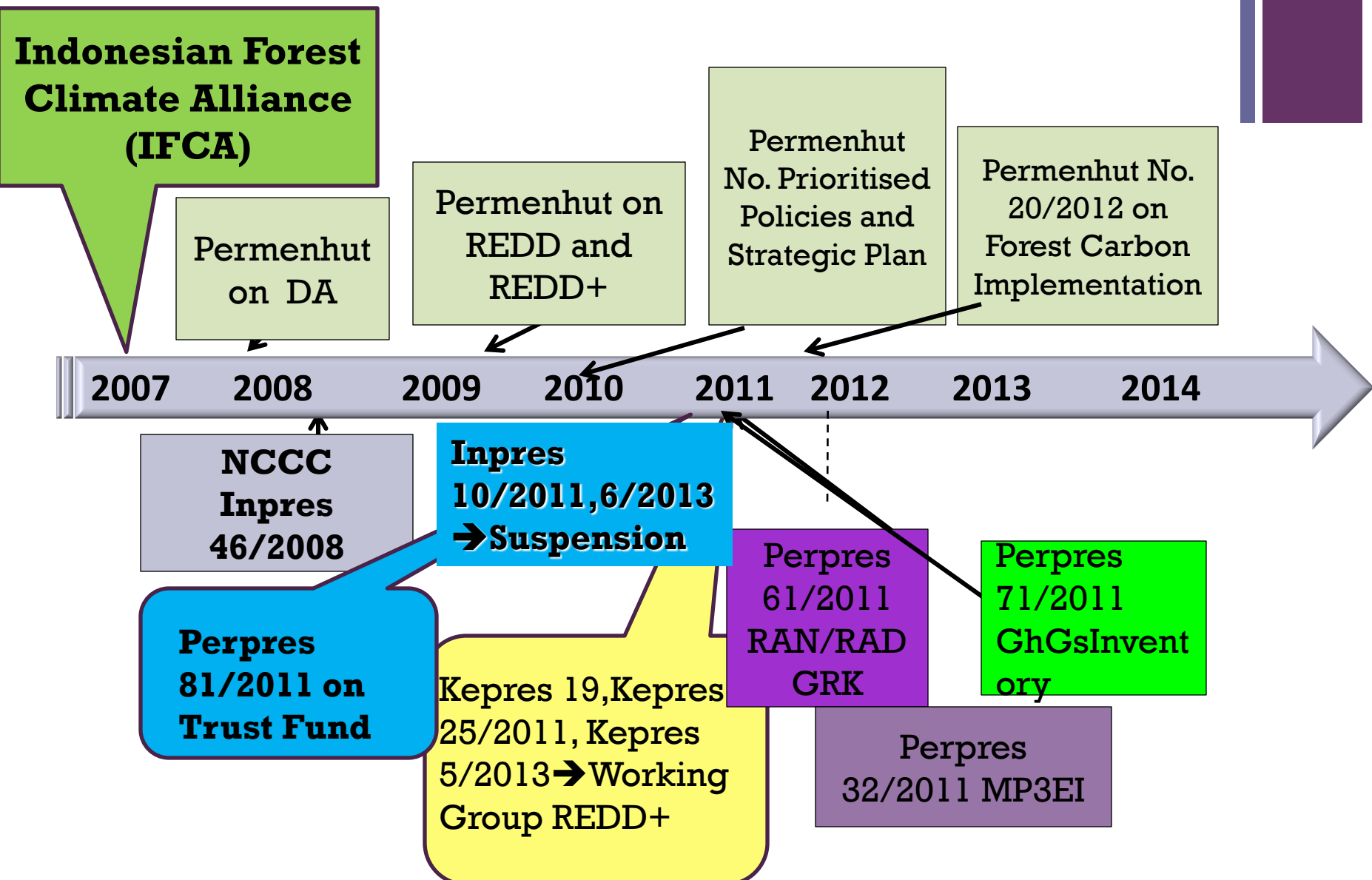

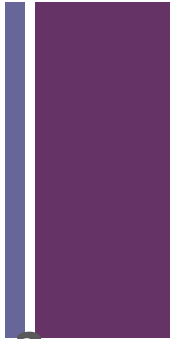


+ Historical Background of REDD+ in Indonesia





Background of FCPF in Indonesia



- Readiness Plan (R-Plan) Indonesia was approved at the PC-3 meeting in Montreux (Resolution PC/3/ 2009/5), June 2009
- Indonesian Readiness Preparation Proposal (R-PP), evolved from R-Plan, was developed from a study by Indonesia Forest Climate Alliance (IFCA) in 2007 → consists of 9 components as guided by R-Plan
- After R-PP was endorsed, several new international cooperations have taken place such as Lol Indonesia-Norway, Indonesia-Jerman, Korea, MfP, JICA, ITTO, and FIP
- FCPF started to operate in semester II-2011 with on budget and on treasury arrangement

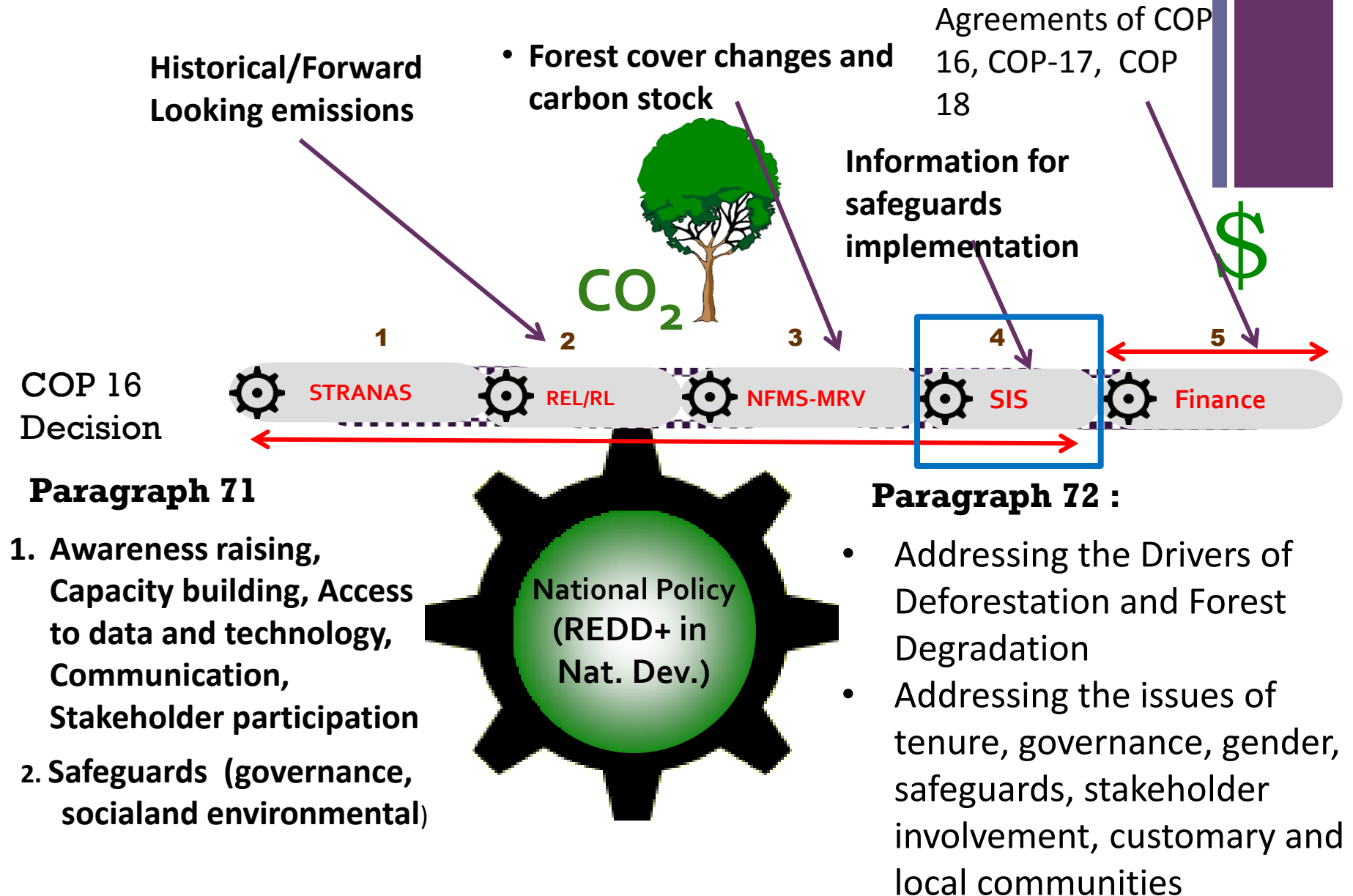

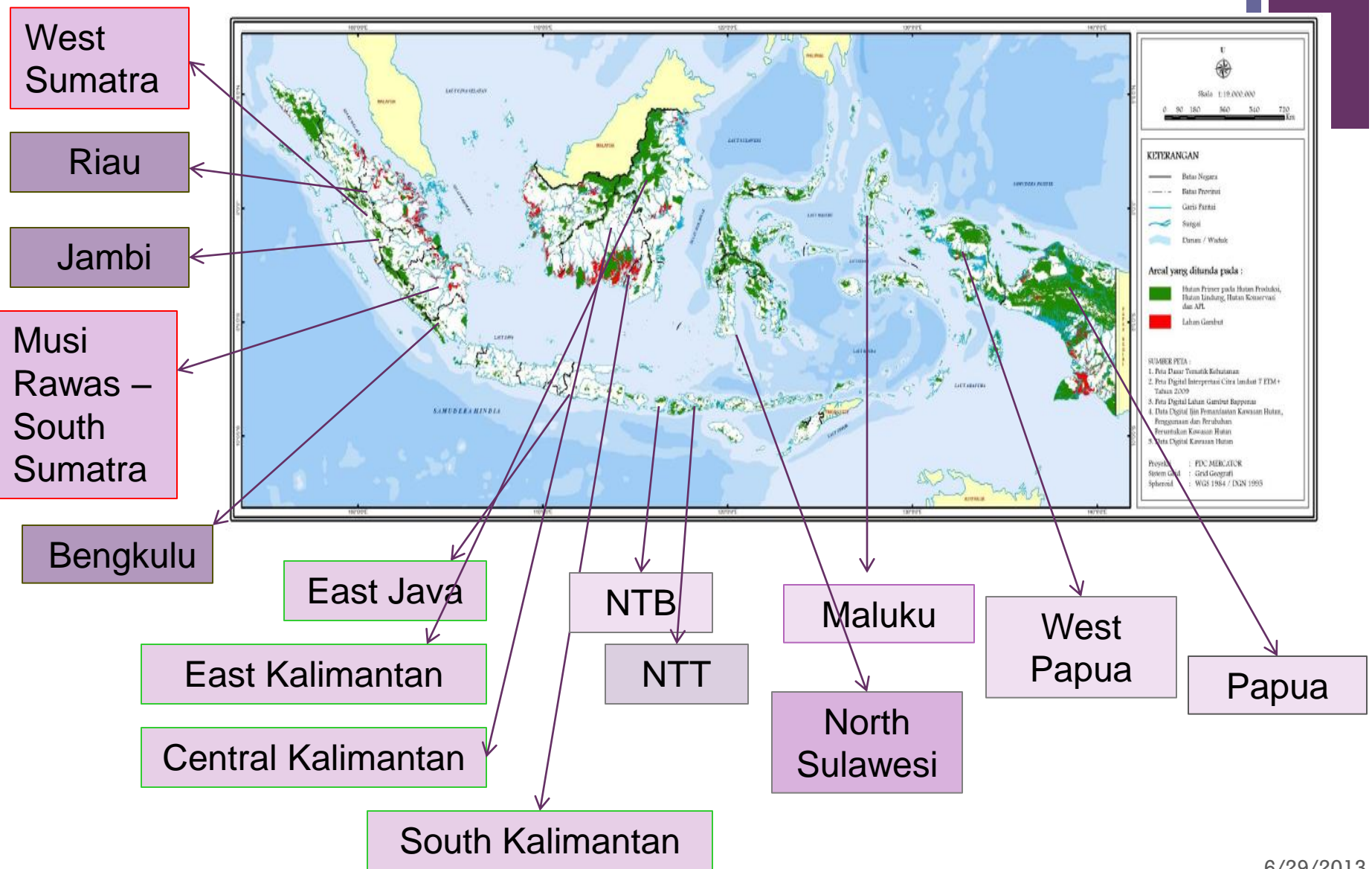

+ Current Status of the REDD+ Readiness Process in Indonesia

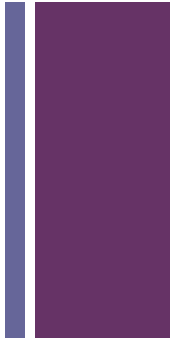
- Indonesia is making significant progress towards REDD+ Readiness:
 - Many Readiness Activities (national & sub-national) have been initiated since 2008
 - National REDD+ Strategy (STRANAS) and Regional Strategy and Action Plan (SRAP), including REL, in 11 Provinces
 - SIS-REDD+ development and continue dialogue for aligning existing (EIA, SIA, SMPF, SFM Sertivication, SVLK, HVCF) and relevant initiatives, including FPIC, PRISAI, and SESA
 - DAs have provided feedbacks on the development of REL/RL
 - Readiness Activities supported by FCPF (Analytical Work, Management of Readiness, REL&MRV, capacity building)

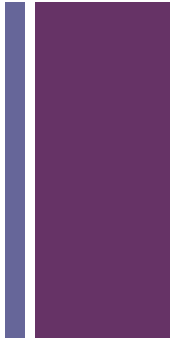
Analytical Works



- Driver of Tree Cover Change: Change in Palm Oil Yield; Poverty Correlation with Forest Loss; Fiscal Transfers (on going)
- Integrating Communities into REDD+ in Indonesia: Aligning international REDD+ funding with long-term community investment; Payments for Environmental Services in Indonesia; Small Grants Programs and REDD+; PNPM as a Potential Disbursement Mechanism for REDD+ (on going)
- Identify Activities within the Country that Result in Reduced Emission and Increased Removals & Stabilization of Forest Carbon Stocks in Papua, East Java, and South Sumatra (on going)



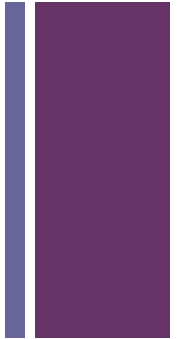
Management of Readiness Process



- Facilitating the Development of REDD+ Framework in 13 Provinces
- Facilitating the Establishment of REDD+ Working Groups or Strengthening the existing REDD+ Working Groups in 3 Provinces → Maluku, West Sumatra, and South Sumatra
- Stakeholder process at the national level to address policy issues, including coordination of readiness activities
- Stakeholder process to identify and address the drivers of deforestation and forest degradation
- Facilitating the establishment of forest and climate change research and education networks → 4 regions
- Establishing Safeguard Information System

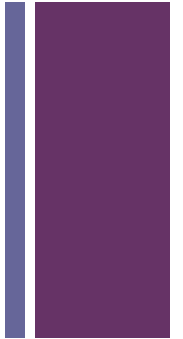
Reference Emissions Level (REL) and Measurement, Reporting and Verification (MRV)



- Establishment of Permanent Sample Plots for ground-based estimating forest carbon accounting and monitoring → 5 provinces
- Development of time series analysis of the primary social, economic and policy aspects of land use change
- Workshops and trainings on MRV
- Workshop on PSP monitoring



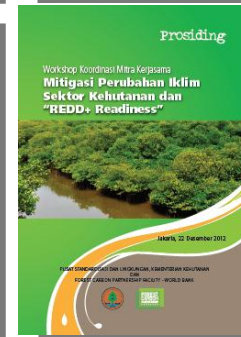
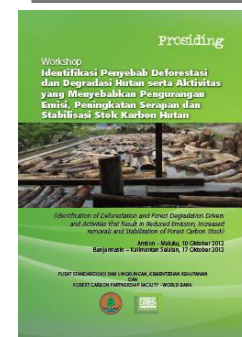
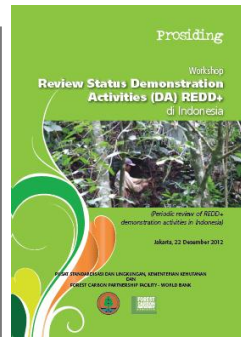
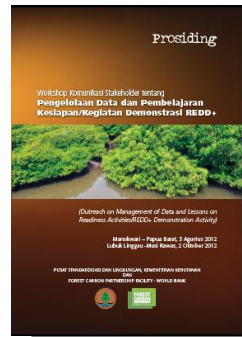
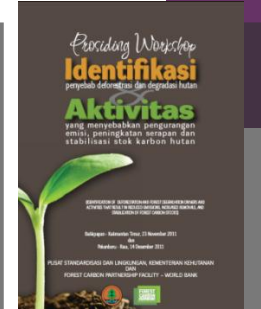
Regional Data Collection and Capacity Building to Support the Establishment of DA



- Development of Socio-economic and bio-physical Baseline Data
- Trainings of Trainers on Forest Carbon Measurement and Monitoring → 4 locations
- Developing Modules for Climate Change and REDD+ Training conducted by Forestry Education and Training Centre (*Pusdiklat kehutanan*)
- Capacity Building to support the development of DA in Forest Management Unit (KPH) → 5 KPHs

+ MTR: National REDD+ Management Arrangements

- *UKP4* (Presidential Work Unit for Development Monitoring and Control of Development) → *SATGAS REDD+* (REDD+ TASK FORCE) → Preparing national REDD+ agency, national REDD+ strategy, guiding provincial REDD+ strategy in 11 prioritised provinces
- Ministry of Forestry leading the process → REDD+ under FCPF and FIP
- National Climate Change Council (DNPI) → national focal point for UNFCCC
- National Forestry Council (*Dewan Kehutanan Nasional*) → Raising Awareness and Developing Safeguards System (SESA)
- Ministry of Environment → National Communication and biannual update report (BUR)
- National Development Planning Agency (BAPPENAS) → RAN/RAD-GRK
- National and Sub-national partners:
 - BAPPEDA → RAD-GRK
 - Dinas Kehutanan (Local Forestry Services) → developing SRAP, demonstration activities, political support
 - University and Research Institutions → scientific collaborators
 - NGOs → raising awareness and community empowerment
 - CSOs → community engagement



Communication, Participation and Outreach

- Overall achievements
 - Public consultation/communication has been conducted by Satgas REDD+, DNPI, Ministry of Forestry, Bappenas, MoE, NGOs, local governments, and all parties related to the development of REDD+ framework

- FCPF Activities
 - SC Meeting: 6 June 2012; 18 February 2013
 - Multi-stakeholder consultations held on 24 May 2013 to address 4 focus areas of FCPF
 - Stakeholder Coordination “Comprehensive Mitigation Action for REDD+”: A Workshop with Resource Persons from Forestry , Finance, Working Group REDD+, Bappenas, NCCC, and Working Group CC MoF





- Public consultation on institutional setting and legal framework
 - Public consultation to facilitate establishment of REDD WG at sub-national level
 - Outreach on Management of Data and Lessons on Readiness Activities/REDD+ Demonstration Activity
 - Public consultation for SESA held by DKN

- Challenges: Needs a policy dialogue to integrate many initiatives of consultation, participation and outreach and to prepare the operationalisation



National REDD+ Strategy Preparation

- National REDD+ Strategy
- SRAP at Provincial level
- **Suspension on new licenses**
- Financing mechanism (Climate Change Trust Fund, FREDDI, Regional Incentive Mechanisms)
- Pilot Province
- Demonstration Activities

* There is a national initiative (RAN/RAD GRK) that need to be taken into account in implementing REDD+ strategy



+ National Forest Monitoring System

- To support the National REDD+ Strategy and the RAN-GRK, while complying with UNFCCC standards (including on reporting co-benefits and safeguards)
- National Activities
 - Development of Action Plan
 - PSP + Inventory
 - Training
- FCPF-financed activities
 - Permanent Sample Plots – National Inventory
 - Capacity building (FORDA, PUSTANLING)



Information System for Multiple Benefits, other Impacts, Governance, and Safeguards

- General → SIS (Safeguards Information System) built on the basis of existing policy instruments and relevant safeguards, including:
 - AMDAL, KLHS, SVLK, PHPL, FSC
 - SESA (Strategic Environmental and Social Assessment)
 - PRISAI (Prinsip, Kriteria, Indikator Safeguards Indonesia) → Principles, Criteria, and Indicators of Indonesian Safeguards
 - FPIC (Free, Prior, Informed, Consent)
- FCPF-financed activities
 - SIS (co financed: PUSTANLING – GIZ – FCPF)



+ Results of the MTR

- FCPF has facilitated the improvement of coordination among different parties at different levels
- National REDD+ strategy has been translated into appropriate regional strategies and action plans
- Determining Reference Emissions Level/Reference Levels at sub-nationals has been carried out using historical data and forward looking analysis. The forward looking method has been used by Papua, Papua Barat, East Kalimantan, and South Sumatra
- National Forest Monitoring System has been launched and is open to be updated, improved, and disseminated
- Need to develop institutional framework at the local level
- Need to integrate existing initiatives of REDD+ safeguards under SIS (Safeguards Information System)

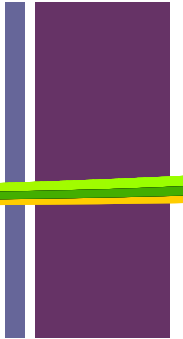




Way Forward

- Complete MTR + request for additional FCPF funding to be submitted for PC 16 meeting
- Scaling up the existing initiatives towards result-based actions and maintaining the consistency between sub-national and national initiatives
- FCPF Readiness Fund needs to or can:
 - Continue facilitating REDD+ program that has been initiated
 - Facilitate the coherence of all efforts for result-based finance towards REDD+ implementation
 - Facilitate the development of REDD+ institutional arrangements and build capacity for current forest management institution, especially forest management unit
 - Integrate local initiatives for carbon monitoring system to the national forest monitoring system
