- 1. The Participants Committee (PC), in its Resolution PC7/2010/4 on Piloting Multiple Delivery Partners (Resolution), decided to establish a Task Force to develop a Common Approach to provide readiness support for REDD countries, and requested the Facility Management Team (FMT) to address financing needs, including an additional budget proposal to the PC, for the purpose of the work by the Task Force.
