Key Messages

Benefits need to be built into all phases of REDD+

Target key actors and tailor incentives to meet their interests and priorities

Ensure legitimacy and equity of program

Benefits during all phases of REDD

Readiness

- REDD+ readiness, capacity building, planning.
- Benefits examples: technical training, data systems, maps, learning and professional exchange, improved stakeholder participation in land use planning, employment opportunities, identification of new enterprises

Early Implementation

- Institutional strengthening, policy reforms and measures, and demonstration activities.
- Benefits examples: cross-sectoral spatial planning, new enterprises, employment, training and capacity, social programs, regulatory streamlining, payfor-performance funding

Full Implementation

- Widespread implementation of strategies, policy reforms, new low-carbon industries. Robust MRV system, Payment for results
- Benefit examples: improved institutional architecture, long and short term employment, new enterprises and low-carbon industries, carbon revenues, technical capacity and partnerships, increased clarity around tenure

Berau Forest Carbon Program (BFCP)



- Berau District, East Kalimantan, Indonesia
- Size: 2.2 million hectares
- Goal: reduce forest loss by:
 - Improving logging practices
 - Shifting oil palm development from primary forests to degraded land
 - Improving spatial planning
 - Community-based sustainable development
