Policy reforms relating to addressing causes of deforestation and forest degradation; respect for traditional knowledge and rights of IPs	Existing Laws and Policies - Forestry Law (IP and local people) - Land Law - Law on Protected areas - Law in Environment Protection and NRM - Subdecree on Economic Land Concession – implementation is now stopped by the govt (???) - Revoke - Subdecree (83) on land registration, communal registration (IP land titling – only 3 has only been recognized by the govt) - Subdecree on social land concessions - Order of government: provide land title to community (new order and action that will benefit for private property for IPs and local people) – this is not good for IPs as it is in conflict with their collective land titling -conflict with economic land concessions - Subdecree on Participatory Land Use Planning - National Forest Programme (2010-2029) – REDD+ Forest cover should not include: rubber plantation, palm oil plantation - Subdecree and guideline on Community Forestry - Order of Prime Minister on REDD implementation Concerns: - Harmonization of laws and policies - Ensure the proper implementation/enforcement of good laws and policies
