CR-WB Partnership for Forestry and Climate Change

- Eco-Market I/PSA Program \$32.6 M Loan 2001-2006
- Eco-Market II/Capacity building and PSA Program \$30 M Loan 2008-2013
- FCPF Programs including Readiness Fund and Carbon Fund for a potential 10 Million ER's ERPA.



Overall FCPF Progress

- The country has been leading by example for many decades.
 With the support of the FCPF Readiness Grant, Costa Rica is now moving towards a new era, as confirmed by its recently submitted INDC.
- For the World Bank this is very strategic involvement in a country that is relying on its forestry sector to contribute to the international commitment of holding global warming to less than 2 degrees C by 2100.
- The Bank is involved in REDD+ in more than 45 countries through the FCPF, and Costa Rica is a recognized pioneer, as the first country to submit an ER-PIN, sign a LOI with the Carbon Fund, and submit an ERPD for TAP review.



Overall Progress with WB as Delivery Partner

- FONAFIFO has made significant and demonstrable progress in addressing identified gaps in staffing numbers, staff capacity, fiduciary and procurement capacities and arrangements with national government agencies and other stakeholders.
- FONAFIFO is also implementing Bank-approved procedures in a satisfactory way to ensure strict compliance with existing rules.



Financial Reporting

Disbursements:

- Grant amount: US\$ 3,600,000
- Disbursed (by June 30, 2015): \$2,285,167
- Disbursed (by October 31, 2015): \$3,016,860
- Grant Start Date/End Date: July 10, 2012 to March 30, 2016



FCPF/PC Endorsement of CR's R-P

- The World Bank highly recommends FCPF/PC endorsement of the CR Readiness Package so that the country can enter into a results-based payment phase and continue with its preparation for REDD+ at the same time.
- Negotiations are underway for a \$100 M loan for an Inclusive and Green Rural Development Program and Climate Change package, compensation for ecosystem services mechanisms, and capacity building (Programa de Desarrollo Verde Inclusivo en Territorios Rurales Productivos).
