Althelia Climate Fund

ACF-I is an innovative fund which is shaping the conservation impact investment sector. We have pioneered a number of "firsts" in this fund including:

- USAID guarantee of 50% at the portfolio level - this was the first carbon DCA
- Developing Nature Conservation Notes with Credit Suisse. This innovative structure was awarded Environmental Finance's Deal of the Year Award in 2015
 Registration Notes with Registration Notes with Properties of the Year 2015
- ACF investment in AIDER with SERNANP in Tambopata National Reserve, Peru was recognised by Momentum for Change as an innovative and transformative solution to deforestation









