Background:

PC Resolution and Implementation Challenges

- PC Resolution 2008-3 Attachment II: Grant Allocation to REDD Country Participants
 - Allocation of Readiness grant of average US\$3.6 million to be disbursed in tranches:
 - \$200,000 R-PP formulation grant and \$3.4 million R-PP preparation grant
 - For R-PP preparation grant, after first US\$2 million is disbursed, the REDD Country Participant will submit a progress report, which is subject to review assessment and review by the PC before any final disbursement is made
- Implementation challenges
 - In practice, R-PP preparation grant (US\$ 3.4 million) is an integrated package for R-PP preparation
 - Difficult to determine the point of disbursement of US\$2 million
 - Putting on hold further disbursements past the US\$2 million point would be inefficient and could cause delays in REDD+ Readiness activities

REDD Country Progress Report

- Charter (Section 6.3(b))
 - REDD Country Participant reports to the PC on its progress of implementation in accordance with timeframe and requirements under the Grant Agreement
- Grant Agreement (Standard Conditions)
 - "Activity Reports" by the recipient countries to the World Bank
- Assessment of report by
 - PC; and
 - The World Bank as the implementing entity to supervise grant implementation
- Consequences of non-performance
 - Failure to fulfill the obligations under the Grant Agreement:
 - Grant suspension
 - Participant lose s its rights and privileges rendered in the Charter and its eligibility to become a PC member

FMT Recommendations

- REDD Country to periodically report to the PC on progress of the implementation of the R-PP Preparation Grant
- Mid-term review
 - The REDD Country Participant will submit a mid-term progress report for PC and World Bank review
 - The timetable shall be jointly agreed by the delivery partner (e.g., the World Bank) and the REDD Country Participant and be reflected in the Grant Agreement
 - The format will be developed by the FMT

• Final report

- REDD Country Participant submits Readiness Package to the PC
 - Reference level
 - REDD+ Strategy
 - MRV system
 - Institutional arrangements for REDD+
