Login & Participation

- > ZOOM link will be provided via calendar invitations only to the registered participants the day before the meeting day (Do not share this link with anyone)
- Please download and install the Zoom application before the meeting you would like to join. Please note that interpretation option is not available when you use the browser.

Your download should automatically start within seconds.

If it doesn't, restart the download

Go to https://zoom.us/download, download the specific version for your device, and run the installation.


Zoom is available on Mobile and Tablet.

- Participants are invited to be familiar with the following relevant features of Zoom:
 - 1. Mute / Unmute: Mute and unmute your microphone.
 - 2. Start Video / Stop Video: Turn your camera on or off.
 - 3. Chat: Access the chat window to chat with the host/co-host.
 - 4. Leave: Leave the meeting while it continues for the other participants.

The following additional features will be especially important for participation in the meeting: **Raise Hand** and **Chat.**




HOW TO RAISE HANDS

- > By using the Raise Hand feature, the participants will inform meeting co-chairs if they wish to speak.
 - Click on the **Participants** button



Click Raise Hand






➤ Co-Chairs will invite members to speak accordingly.

Once your intervention is done, please click the **Raise Hand** button again to lower your hand.

HOW TO USE CHAT

The chat function will be available for meeting participants to chat with everyone in the meeting or send private messages to another participant.

The chat function is also an alternative solution for users who are not able to use the **Raise Hand** feature via Zoom

BEST PRACTICE

Stay on mute if you are not talking.

- Be aware of your audio and video settings.
- Use the video option when possible (High Speed Internet required).
- Make sure you have a good light in the room.
- Look into the camera when talking.
- Ensure that you have a work-appropriate background.

HOW TO DOWNLOAD ZOOM APP ON SMARTPHONE (BACKUP OPTION)

- a. Android instructions
- b. iPhone instructions
 - Open app store and type Zoom
 - Look for "Zoom Cloud Meetings"
 - Download the app as any other
 - Once it is downloaded on the phone, you will have the icon
